


#### Importance of Research for Education's future

#### NAAC Peer Team Visit

India has one of the largest and diverse education systems in the world. Privatization, widespread expansion, increased autonomy and introduction of Programmes in new and emerging areas have improved access to higher education. At the same time, it has also led to widespread concern on the quality and relevance of the higher education. To address these concerns the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was established in 1994 as an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission (UGC) with its Head Quarter in Bengaluru. The NAAC has been set up to facilitate the volunteering institutions to assess their performance vis-a-vis set parameters through introspection and a process that provides space for participation of the institution.

In this regard a three member National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Peer team visited the college for assessing Aurora PG College (MBA) on 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> October 2018. The Peer Team comprised of Prof. B. A. Prajapati Vice Chancellor, Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Chairperson-NAAC Peer Team, Dr. Siddheshwar Tukaram Gadade, Principal, Changu Kana Thakur Arts, Commerce and Science College, New Panvel, Member Co-ordinator, Peer Team, Dr. S. Mufeed Ahmad, Professor & Dean, Department of Management Studies, University of Kashmir, Member-NAAC Peer Team.

NAAC has identified a set of seven criteria to serve as the basis of its assessment procedures. To assess the criteria NAAC scheduled the visit in two days. The team on the first day interacted with Director, Dr. M. Madhavi who gave a detailed presentation on admission process, performance of students in academics, research facilities, activities in departments, student and faculty achievements, research publications. The team later visited the institution and interacted with the Principal, IQAC Steering Committee members, staff, alumni and parents. Later during the day a scintillating cultural programme was presented in their honor by the students.

On the second day, the visiting team prepared a detailed report ensuring all the requisites of the NAAC were covered. The exit meeting was held with all management and staff present. The peer team handed over the assessment report to Dr. Ramesh Babu Nimmatoori- Secretary, Aurora Educational Society, Sri. N. Raja Babu- Chairman, Aurora Educational Society and Dr. M. Madhavi – Director.



#### Guest Lecture on "Importance of exercising voting right"

In a democracy, a government is chosen by voting in an election: a way for an electorate to elect, i.e. choose, among several candidates for rule. Many countries use a secret ballot, a practice to prevent voters from being intimidated and to protect their political privacy. Voting is a fundamental right of any citizen that enables them to choose the leaders of tomorrow. In many countries, the minimum age for voting is 18 years. Voting not only enables the citizens to vote for political parties, but it also helps them to realize the importance of citizenship. Many people do not vote thinking one vote will not make a change, but as a matter of fact, it does. A nation's political foundations are built using elections. Young voters notoriously neglect the importance of voting, but their voice is an important one on both sides of the aisle. Key issues in every election increasingly relate to the concerns of students and professionals between the ages of 18 and 29, making it essential for members within that age group to educate themselves on political issues and take to the polls. While millennials represented nearly 50% of the entire voter population in the 2016 election, they were further divided along race, gender, and education lines when considering key issues from both candidates.

In order to increase the awareness of exercising the voting right a guestlecture on "Importance of exercising voting right" was organized on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2018. Mr. Ravi Kumar, CI Uppal Police station and Mr. Jay Chandra SI Uppal Police Station, addressed the students. Mr. Ravi Kumar, CI Uppal Police station spoke about the importance of "Utilizing the voting right". He highlighted about democracy system in India. He emphasized on the importance of voting, how to exercise a voting right and the role of the youth in selecting a good leader for the nation. He highlighted on how the leaders are selected by the people, for the people through the people. He enlightened about the nuances followed by the election commission. He spoke about the unique Internet-based beta version of an Android-based application is called 'C-VIGIL', which stands for "citizen's vigil", using which a person can secretly send to it geo-tagged videos and photos of illegal money being distributed or a hate speech being made during polls, when there any poll code violation.

Mr. Jaya Chandra, Sub-Inspector, Uppal Police station, spoke about the manner in which he exercised his voting right and the usage of voting machine and the usage of NOTA as well. Students of MBA, MCA and I-MBA attended the Lecture and were well benefitted. They got motivated to exercise their voting right.



#### Guest Lecture on "Entrepreneurship Development"

BharatiyaYuva Shakti Trust, (BYST) is a platform for empowering Indian youth to turn their business ideas into profitable enterprises, with guidance and support of a mentor. With an aim to channelize the power of India's youth towards economic development, BYST's principles are based on the famous words of Mr JRD Tata- "If we touch one life, it has the potential to transform the lives of a billion people". By adopting the ancient Guru-Shishya "Parampara", BYST mentors instill values and a sense of self-confidence in their respective mentees.

To promote the awareness and increase the entrepreneurial skills a guest lecture on the topic "Entrepreneurship Development" was organized in association with BYST, Hyderabad. Mr. Laxman Ramesh the Chairman of BYST addressed the faculty and students of MBA. He shared his experience of how he became an entrepreneur and his role as the chairman of BYST. He motivated the students to pursue entrepreneurship as a career. He spoke about how BYST can help students in their entrepreneurship endeavor. Students of MBA, MCA and I-MBA have participated in the session.





#### Workshop on Usage of Voting Machine



The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC), in a bid to ensure complete awareness on the use of the Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) with Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs), has set up a number of training centers across Hyderabad ahead of the impending elections in the state. Under the awareness drive, 58 EVM/VVPAT centers and nine mobile polling stations have been deployed for three different zones across 15 assembly constituencies in Hyderabad. They wanted to make students get a feel of actual polling stations.

To increase the awareness on EVM Machines and the usage of the EVM's, aworkshop on "Usage of Voting Machines" was organized on 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. In this regard a team of members from Greater Hyderabad Muncipal Corporation (GHMC)educated the students by providing a demo on Usage of EVM Machines. Mr. C. Narasimha Rao advised the students to enroll for 2019 elections. They also educated the students the

importance of exercising the vote right and their role in educating the public. Later the students were demonstrated about the options available in the voting Machine. Students of MBA, MCA and I-MBA have participated in the workshop.



#### Workshop on "Blue Ocean Dialogue"



Young Indians (Yi) is an integral part of CII, formed in 2002 as a PAN India platform for young Indians to realize the dream of a developed nation. Through its programs and initiatives, it reaches out to millions of youth across the country with the clarion call to action of 'We Can, We Will'. YUVA is the student wing of Yi, where the students are involved to develop leadership, personal development and nation building activities.

The resource person Mr. Rohit K. Kountia, Executive Director, Insulation Pvt Ltd explained the students about the concept of Blue Ocean and how it can be useful to confront daily life problems. The purpose of the workshop was to introduce the participating students, to the concept of 'Blue Ocean' Strategy. 'Blue Ocean' is a term used to refer to clean, pristine market spaces. These are areas where customers exist but there are extremely limited or no competitors. Blue Oceans emerged based on new needs, new consumer habits, changed habits, new product development, etc. In the context of this workshop a Blue Ocean will refer to 'New Ideas', Innovation that have never been thought of before, to make them challenge the existing ways of doing thing by changing the status quo. "There are certain aspects that we should keep in mind before we innovate any product or service, the first is addressing a 'Habit', he habit will define how the product/ service will sell based on which we decide the "Who", "Who" will be the range of target customer, and finally comes "Why" or more precisely the unique factor that differentiates your product from competition."

To involve the students in the workshop, a competition was devised where in the students were asked to develop a product or service that would help in achieving their vision on "Measures of Road Safety" using their Imagination" and then they were taught how they can apply the concept of 'Habit, Who and Why' in the process.





#### Bathukamma Celebrations

Bathukamma means 'Mother Goddess comes alive' and the festival represents the cultural spirit of Telangana, symbolizing the patron Goddess of womanhood. The festival is also regarded as the Spring Festival of Goddess Gauri. Bathukamma festival is a floral festival and during the festival, a beautiful flower stack is arranged in a unique style in shape of a temple, which usually consists of seasonal flowers, having medicinal values. The festival is celebrated with joy and happiness as there are dance performances, music, dramas etc.

Bathukamma comes during the latter half of monsoon, before the onset of winter. he festival begins a week before the 'SaddulaBathukamma' (the grand finale of the Bathukamma festival) which falls two days before Dassera. The flowers are carefully arranged row after row in a brass plate (called 'taambalam') in circular rows and in alternate colours. The Bathukamma grows in size and the bigger it gets the better. The white 'gunuka' flowers are coloured using water paints and Bathukamma gets colourful circular layers of them along with 'tangedu' in between. The Bathukamma is then placed before the family deity and prayers are offered. As evening approaches the womenfolk dress colorfully in best of their attire and adorn lot of ornaments and place the Batukamma in their courtyard. The women of neighborhood also gather in a large circle around it. They start singing songs by making rounds around them repeatedly, building a beautiful human circle of unity, love, sisterhood.

Bathukamma is celebrated by cultural club - Aaroop on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. The arrangements were all in their place with the collective efforts from students and a competition was organized for the making of Bathukamma Palettes. This small competition as an activity flourished joyfulness and competitiveness among students. The colors and fragrances of flowers with the arrangements and participation of students released the "Celebration of Color and Life". The program concluded with the immersion of Bathukamma flowers in nearby lake with lot of cheers, claps and happiness by students. The festival heralds the beauty of nature, collective spirit of Telangana people, the indomitable spirit of womenfolk and also the ecological spirit of the agrarian people in preserving the natural resources in a festive way.

#### International Girl Child Day
